Because our district is organized in a campus, all students in grades 7 and 8 are assigned to Mill Creek Middle School.

- Our school improvement plan is aligned with the district's strategic plan and includes goals to improve all students' reading, and math proficiency. One of our primary areas of work in the coming year will be related to the development of mastery learning opportunities including learning targets and project based learning. Mill Creek operates on a mastery grading system in which 85% of a grade is on summative assessments and 15% is on formative assessments. Students will be given ample opportunities to gain mastery of the grade level content expectations.
