Dexter's spring sports teams had another successful season this year, with several teams win-ning their league or district championships. Both the varsity **Baseball** and **Softball** teams ended spectacular seasons as SEC-Red District Champions, and **Men's Lacrosse** shared the SEC-White Championship with Chelsea.

In Track and Field, senior **Sophia Mettes** repeated as State Champion in the pole vault with a height of 13 ft. 6 in., breaking the DHS school record for pole vault. Two other Track & Field school records were broken this season: **Johnny Adamczyk, Cole Cabana, Micah Davis**, and **Cole Sheldon** finished the Mens 4x200 Relay with a time of 1:29.17, and senior **Jamie Geise** threw the shot put for a record-breaking distance of 43 ft. 6.5 in.
