Seventh Grade Immunization Requirements 2015-2016

Michigan law requires that all seventh graders immunization status be assessed. Parents/guardians must provide an immunization record that documents that the child has received <u>all</u> of the required immunizations or at least one dose of each required immunization and is not yet due for the next dose. If a nonmedical waiver is desired, the parent/guardian must make an appointment at Washtenaw County Public Health to receive science-based vaccine education and a certified waiver. Call 734-544-6700 for an appointment

The immunization record is due at registration or no later than the first day of school.

Refer to the chart below to determine if your child is up-to date with their required vaccines. Schedule an appointment immediately if your child is in need of vaccines so there will be no delay in your child's admission to school.

Required Immunizations for Entry Requirements for all Michigan Public and Non-Public School Seventh Graders

Diphtheria, Tetanus,	4 doses Diphtheria and Tetanus OR 3 doses of Td if
Pertussis	#1 given on or after the first birthday. 1 dose of

Polio	4 doses of polio. Only 3 doses of polio are required
	if dose 3 is administered on or after the fourth
	birthday.
Measles, Mumps, Rubella*	2 doses on or after 12 months of age
Hepatitis B*	3 doses
Meningococcal	1 dose for all children 11 years of age or older
	upon entry into 7 th grade or higher
Varicella*(Chickenpox)	2 doses of Varicella vaccine at or after 12 months
	of age or current lab immunity or reliable history
	of disease.

^{*}Current laboratory evidence of immunity is acceptable instead of immunization with antigen

^{**}All doses of vaccine must be given with appropriate spacing between doses and at appropriate ages to be considered valid.

⁻Hepatitis A, HPV and a yearly Influenza vaccine are additional vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices and the American Academy of Pediatricians.
