To Whom It May Concern:

Please consider this letter as verification of the Dexter Community School District's tax exempt status.

As an instrumentality of a governmental unit, the Dexter Community School District is not subject to Federal income tax under the provisions of Section 115(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, which states in part:

"Gross income does not include income derived from the exercise of any essential governmental function and accruing to a State or any political subdivision thereof . . . "

Because the Dexter Community School District is an instrumentality of a governmental unit, contributions are deductible under Section 170(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code, which states:

"For purposes of this section, the term "charitable contribution" means a contribution or gift to or for the use of-

A State, a possession of the United States, or any political subdivision of any of the foregoing, or the United States or the District of Columbia, but only if the contribution is made for exclusively public purposes."

The schools in the Dexter Community School District include Anchor Elementary School, Beacon Elementary School, Wylie Elementary School, Creekside Intermediate School, Mill Creek Middle School, Dexter High School, and Bates School. Also included are programs operated by the Dexter Community School District including Children Services, Community Education, Jenkins Early Childhood Learning Center, Food & Nutrition Services, all Dexter Athletic Programs, and all Dexter School/Student Activities.
