<u>Teachers needed!!!</u> The State of Michigan has created a series of teacher certification options to help support Michigan residents in becoming teachers. For example:

- The MI Future Educator Fellowship provides \$10,000 per year for tuition for prospective teachers.
- The MI Future Educator Stipend provides a \$9,600 stipend to student teachers.
- The Future Proud Michigan Educator Programs provide a variety of teacher certification options.
- If you already are a Michigan-certified teacher and are interested in becoming certified as a Special Education teacher, Michigan has created a Special Education Teacher Tuition Reimbursement Grant that will pay for the first 18 credits and provide immediate special education teacher temporary approval that allows individuals to immediately begin in a special education teaching role. In addition, the State of Michigan has created the Michigan Achievement Scholarships that provide students, starting with the Class of 2023:

Up to \$2,750 if they attend a community college, per year
Up to \$5,500 if they attend a public university, per year
Up to \$4,000 if they attend a private college or university, per year.
