Dexter Community School District received an official notice of noncompliance on April 15, 2016 for Timely Individualized Education Plans (IEPs). This noncompliance was identified through data submitted to the Michigan Student Data System (MSDS) in school year 2014-2015. The Michigan Department of Education, Office of Special Education (MDE, OSE) has received further evidence and has determined some of the IEPs reviewed were held on time.

Your district no longer meets the threshold set for completing a Corrective Action Plan (CAP). If a CAP was issued to address the noncompliance, it will be removed from the Continuous Improvement Monitoring System (CIMS).

The Cross Indicator Analysis is still required and is due on February 1, 2017. The data used to develop Determinations and the Strand report will reflect your increased compliance rate.
