# 403(b) ADOPTION AGREEMENT FOR

The undersigned Eligible Employer, by executing this Adoption Agreement, elects to establish a 403(b) plan ("Plan"). The Employer, subject to the Employer's Adoption Agreement elections, adopts fully the Prototype Plan provisions. This Adoption Agreement, the basic plan document, any Funding Vehicle Documentation, and any attached agreements, appendices or addenda, constitute the Employer's entire plan document.
