

2018 SUMMER CAMP PROGRAMS

CAMP DEXTER

Camp Dexter is a traditional day camp for children who have completed one year of full-day school through the 5th grade. Students are grouped by age within the program. We offer weekly themes, indoor/outdoor games, swimming, crafts and other tabletop activities, camper's choice time and weekly field trips. All staff are CPR and first aid certified. Transportation is provided by Dexter school buses. Hours are 8:45am-3:15pm with before camp care beginning at 7:30am and after camp care ending at 6pm.

Weekly themes and field trips will be available and posted online in April, and will include the Toledo Mud Hens game on July 17 and Rolling Hills Water Park on Aug 15. We're considering trips to the DNR Adventure Center, Toledo Zoo, Skyzone, Quality 16 Theater, Blue Heron Bay Spray Park and more. Local walking trips include parks, the library and Dairy Queen.

Camp Dexter operates June 18 thru August 17 with the exception of the two weeks of Camp Invention, June 25-29 and August 6-10. Closed on July 4.

Fees: A camp registration fee of \$75 for the first child and \$40 for each additional child is required at the time of enrollment. The maximum registration fee for a family is \$150. The camp fees are \$240/week, \$220/siblings or \$60/day (with a minimum registration of three days until June 1). Early bird fees thru May 4 are: \$220/week, \$200/siblings or \$55/day. **Online registration is not available for Camp Dexter.** Information and forms are available at the after care site, the Community Education office and on our website. Select Community Education Department and choose Camp Dexter. Return your paperwork, along with registration fee(s), to our office asap to reserve your space.
