- Because our district is organized in a campus, all students in grades 7 and 8 are assigned to Mill Creek Middle School.
- Our school improvement plan is aligned with the district's strategic plan and includes goals to improve all student's reading, writing, and math proficiency. Teachers have implemented project based learning strategies in their classes. We have made a concerted effort to take a truly personalized and individualized approach to learning for our students. Teachers are making significant efforts to meet students where they are from a developmental level. We also support a mastery learning model where students have the opportunity to master grade level content expectations before moving on.

- Mill Creek Middle School also assessed its students using NWEA in both Math and Reading.
