Dear Dexter Families and Staff,

It's been an exciting summer filled with construction and preparations for the 2019-2020 school year. Below are a few updates:

WISD Bond Proposal: On the August 6th ballot, the Washtenaw Intermediate School District (WISD) has a 0.37 mill (10 year) bond proposal to fund a new High Point School. High Point School serves students from all nine Washtenaw County School Districts, including Dexter. High Point School is specifically dedicated to meet the specialized needs of students with disabilities from ages 3 through 26 by offering programming for students with severe cognitive and multiple impairments. The Dexter Community Schools Board of Education unanimously passed a resolution supporting the WISD bond proposal on May 6, 2019.
