Dear DCS Parents and Community,

On the November 7th election ballot is a Washtenaw ISD Special Education Millage Renewal Proposal. The proposal is a renewal of an existing millage that expires in 2017. The millage generates \$15 million to serve over 6,500 public school students benefiting from Special Education services in Washtenaw County. For DCS, this special education millage provides approximately \$978,000. Information on the millage can be found at <http://tinyurl.com/WISDMillage2017>.

Anyone registered to vote who resides in any Washtenaw County School District is eligible to vote on this proposal regardless of whether or not their home is in Washtenaw County. Several school districts in Washtenaw County, including DCS, extend into neighboring counties as part of their school district boundaries. As a result, many homes in Livingston, Jackson, Lenawee, Monroe, and Wayne Counties are located within the Washtenaw Intermediate School District boundaries.
